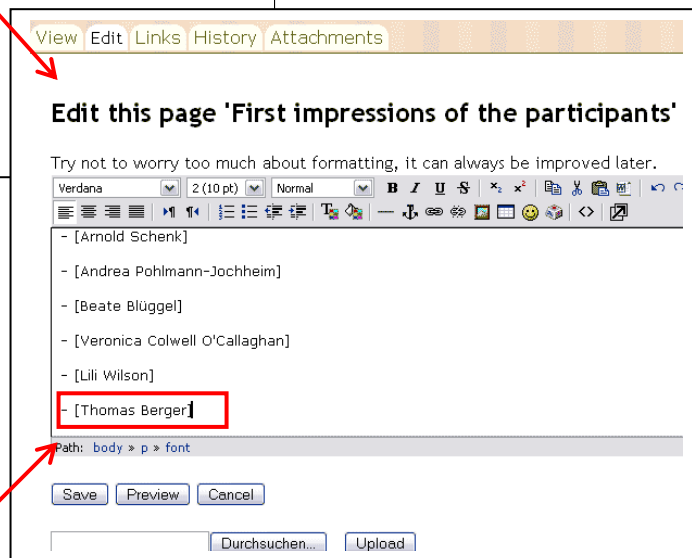


How to add new pages to the wiki of moodle



First to remark is, that wiki pages could not be created as a standalone page. A new wiki page must be linked with at least one other page. Cause of this you start not with the empty page, you start with the link which point to the new page.

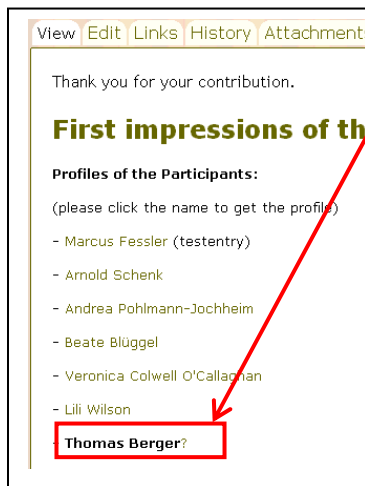
1. Please open the page where this link should be an start the "Edit" mode.



You see, every link to an other page is in squared bracket.

To create a new page, write the topic of the page just in squared brackets.

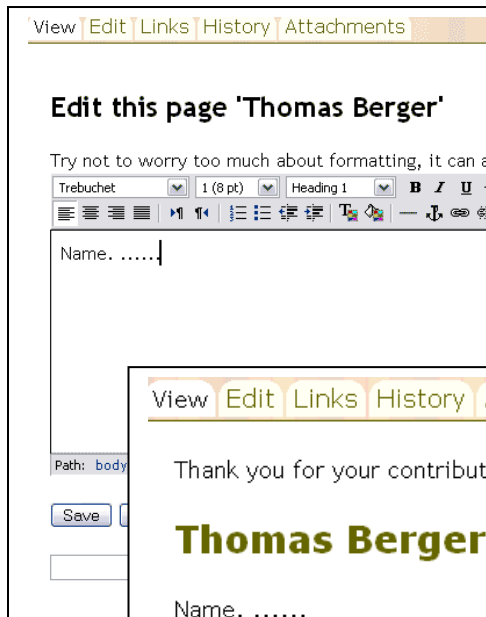
Now, just press "Save"



You will see the link to the new page printed strong and at the end with an question mark.

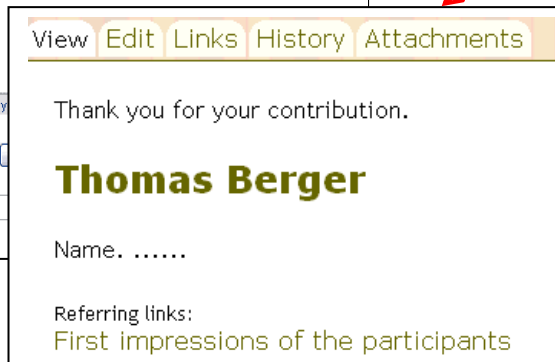
The new, empty page is still created, the question mark means - "please add something to the page".

To add text, pictures ... you only should click the question mark.



The click on the question mark opens the known edit box.

After adding information to the page, please press "Save" and you will get a view of the added page.



You can also use the windows copy function to add new date to the page.
